FIRE —

FOCUS —

Hope Rescue Mission has so many opportunities to do good things-GREAT things-but we are relentlessly committed to doing the God things. Your support makes a way for us to provide HOPE, RESCUE those in darkness, and TRANSFORM lives from merely surviving to thriving. FUNCTION —

2021 was a record year for **HOPE THRIFT BOUTIQUE**, providing an integral function of the Mission. With guidance from our leadership team, our Board of Directors, and through prayerful consideration, we are on the lookout for separate office space for 549-HOPE and administration.

549-HOPE has seen steady growth in the number of individuals seeking assistance, those being served, and the resources being dispensed to meet needs in the community. 549-HOPE Staff and Volunteers are grateful to you, our supporters, for your generosity to help meet needs like gas, housing services, food, backpacks and emergency shelter.

Elemental (and exponential!) growth within Hope Rescue Mission is quickly taking place! Growth within our programs mean more people to operate them, more opportunities for volunteers to serve, and more lives to be reached.

549-HOPE GROWTH:

- **Served** 16% MORE people in 2021 than 2020
- Disbursed 226% MORE church and community resources in 2021 over 2020
- **Saved** 10% more in resources in 2021 vs. 2020 (through self-resolution and assistance advocacy)

Temporary Safe Outdoor Space GROWTH:

- **Served** 105 individuals since its inception in December 2020
- **Transitioned** 33 people into permanent housing
- At least 4 people gave their **lives to Christ** while at TSOS

Grace House Graduates GROWTH:

- Program graduates continue to grow in their new homes, jobs, schools, and communities.
- **Connections** made while at Grace House continue to uplift and uphold them in prayer.
- **Discipleship** continues to mature each one in their identities in Christ.
