Though now you wouldn't know it, Mike, an employee of the Temporary Safe Outdoor Space, once had a different story. Spending most of his life on the streets, in and out of jail, and battling addictions, most people gave up on him. He was seen as completely hopeless. A moment that stuck out was when he was sitting in the back of a police car after being arrested and he noticed his profile on the police

officer's computer. It said in big red letters, "Career Criminal"

Through a miraculous turn of events, God started to direct Mike's steps forward. While walking in town, a truck drove by him that said "go to rehab" on it, and unexpectedly, it was at this moment he decided to finally go for help. Upon graduating from the rehab program, Mike said "I was anxious to leave, but I had nowhere to go. I don't have any family here, so I was headed back to the street." It was right before going back to homelessness that Mike was led to Hope Rescue Mission's Temporary Safe Outdoor Space. By the grace of God, Mike was able to immediately get into "TSOS" and continue his journey of hope and healing.

Though shelter is important, this is just the first step for our clients when they enter into our user agreement at TSOS. Our aim is to help each person move forward towards stability, and a huge part of that is getting a job. Though not having a job for seven years because of his addictions, Mike was uncertain about how he could attain employment. Incredibly, in the first week of TSOS, Mike applied for a job and started working the very next day. As a result, he was able to save money and eventually secure an apartment!

Through the ups and downs in his journey, Mike said he was met with grace each time from the staff at TSOS, and they never gave up on him. He mentioned it was the staff's lived experience that really helped Mike feel comfortable to share, because they knew what he was going through. Now, when talking about working at TSOS, Mike has the opportunity to be that encouragement to others. He hopes he can at least "inspire one person to go to rehab, or turn their life around and show it's possible".

As Mike reflects on his life, he says "I wouldn't be here right now if it wasn't for Hope Rescue Mission". Everyone else gave up on him, yet with a little more time, cultivation, and compassion Mike has been able to move forward to stability. Two years after going to rehab, Mike is working two jobs and still in his apartment he got after going through TSOS.

HOPE RESCUE MISSION OUTPREACH DROP-IN-CENTER


With the city closing Johnson Street Shelter in the next few months, we are expecting to see an increase of people at our Drop-In Center. So far, in 2025, we have already seen a staggering number of people in need of help. In the first three months of this year we have already had 984 people come through our doors in need of assistance and rest. Thankfully, we have still been able to handle this growth due to all the hard work of our team as they have continually improved systems, procedures, and partnerships! This year we have helped in the following ways -

- 120 people have been served with gas and laundry cards
- 18 people helped with rental assistance
- 17 bus tickets
- 16 people assisted with propane to stay warm
- 14 hotel stays
- **12** birth certificates
- 8 assisted with obtaining I.D's
- **5** helped with getting car parts for repairs

These are just some of the many ways our team has helped give hope to those in urgent need this year, while also leaning on Jesus for insight!
